The restoration of the wetland aims to protect mahinga kai (traditional food and resource gathering) values and contribute towards improving water quality in Wainono Lagoon.

The Punatarakao wetland planting day is being supported by the Lower Waitaki South Coastal Canterbury Water Zone Committee, the Ministry for Primary Industries, Department of Conservation and the Department of Corrections (who propagated the seedlings).
